#### Meet Reverend Audrey Mangum.

Rev. Mangum recently served as Director of Justice & Mission Engagement for the Greater Detroit District and as Administrative Assistant for the United Methodist Union of Greater Detroit. She holds an Associate of Arts degree in Sociology from Morristown College, Morristown, Tennessee (1977-1978); a Bachelor of Arts in Elementary Education from Adrian College, Adrian, Michigan (1979-1981); Master of Divinity degree from Methodist Theological School in Ohio (Spring 2021); and completed 25 hours toward a Master of Arts degree in Instructional Technology at Wayne State University (1995-1998. She currently serves as Director of Justice & Mission Engagement for the Greater Detroit District and as Administrative Assistant for the United Methodist Union of Greater Detroit where she has served since 2017 and 2014, respectively. Her involvement in United Methodist ministry in Michigan is extensive and consequential. Rev. Mangum served as Campus Administrator at the Brightmoor Campus of Redford: Aldersgate UMC from 2014 to 2017. She is currently the Director and Administrative Dean & Registrar of the Urban Methodist Youth Camp, and Coordinator of the Greater Detroit District Children and Youth Ministries Committee. She previously served as Senior Administrative Specialist and Business Analyst for SYNC Technologies from 2007 to 2012. From 1984 to 1985, she served as Administrative Assistant in the Office of the Executive Secretary of India, Pakistan, Nepal & Bangladesh at the General Board of Global Ministries of The United Methodist Church in New York City. She served as an Adult Education Teacher in the Detroit Public Schools from 1989 to 1991 and as an Elementary Education Teacher for the Ecorse Public Schools from 1991-1992.

Reverend Mangum will serve her first episcopal appointment here at Conant and comes with extensive administrative, technology, and ministry experience. She is a recognized children and youth ministry leader, and a committed mother. She is the mother of one adult son, Erron Mangum, and looks forward to helping build Conant Avenue UMC for the future.


